Being a Carer means supporting Gary to gain access to activities he needs or wants. It's a position of trust and a role I take very seriously, especially as his ad... see more

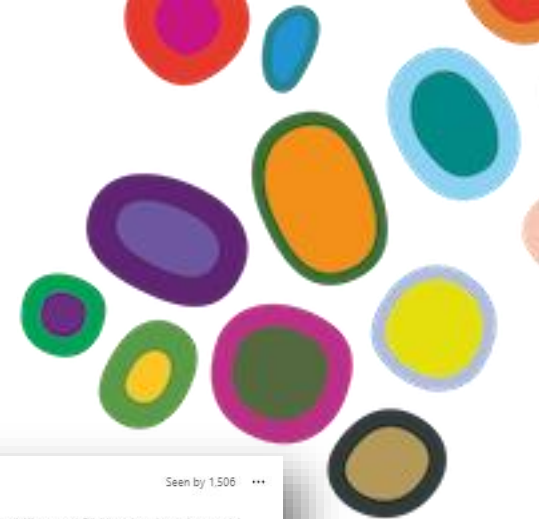
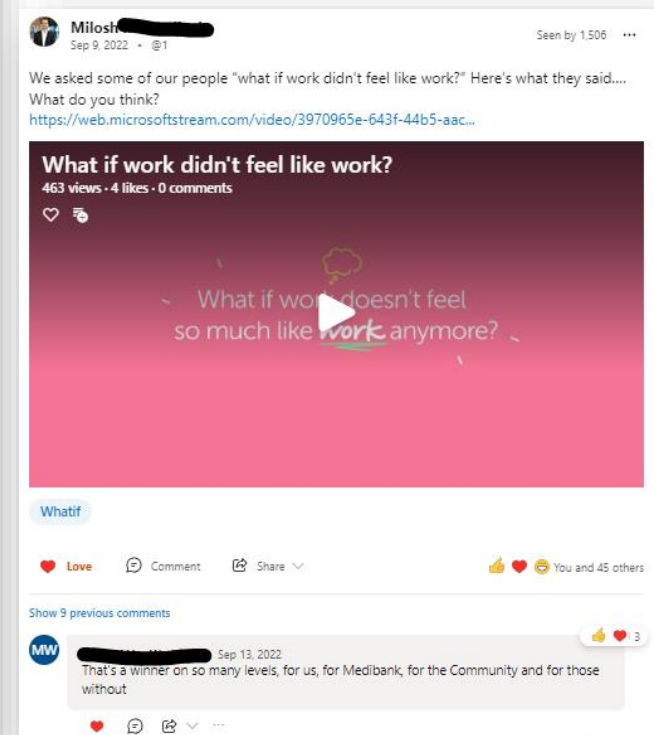
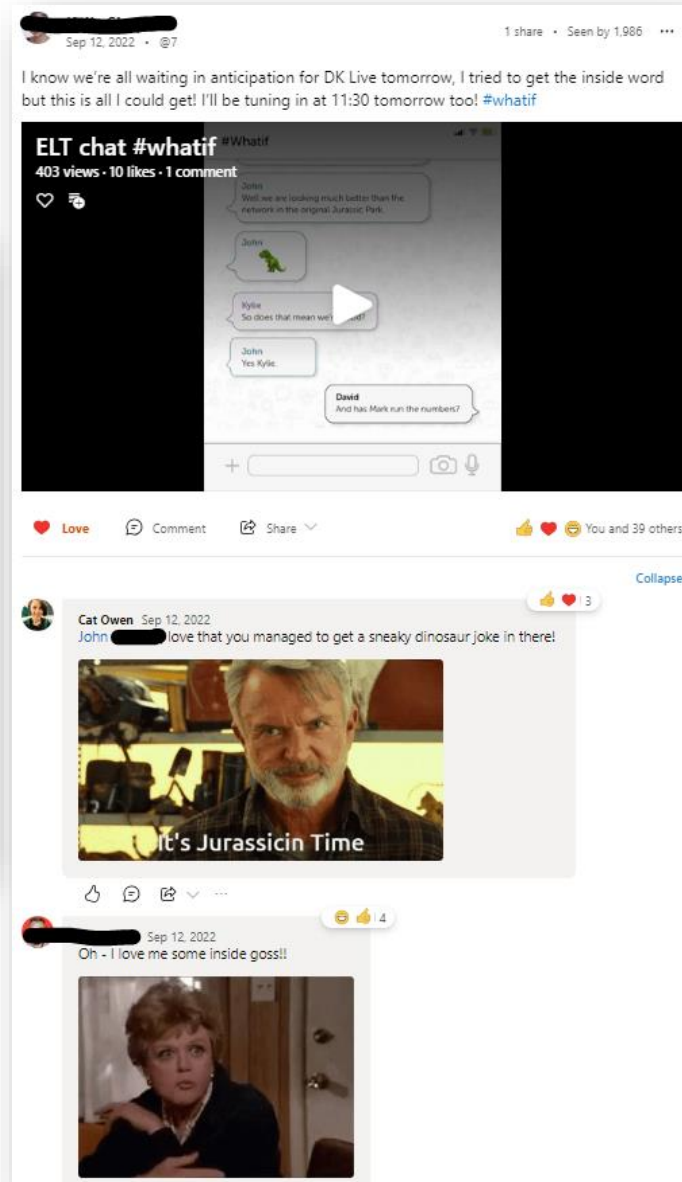
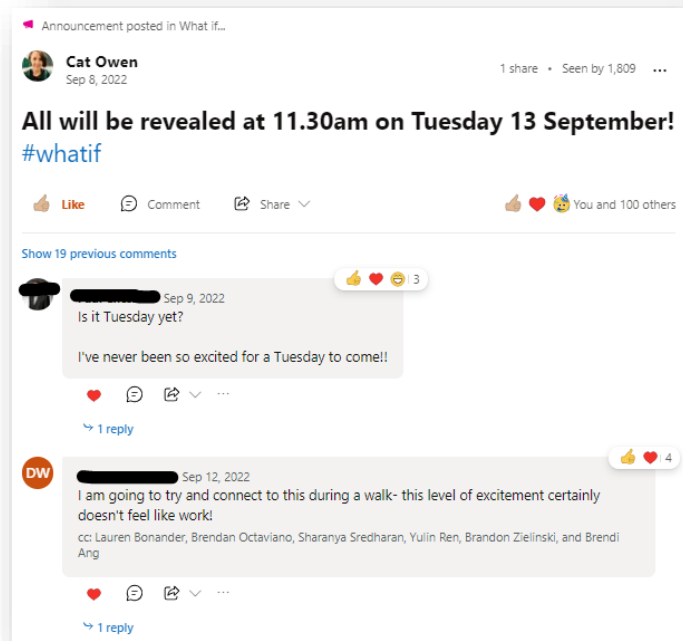
